

Dr. Craig S. Turley, President of the Redlands Charitable Resources Coalition, Inc., was born in Inglewood, CA in 1955. A resident of the Redlands area for 56 years, he graduated from Redlands HS in 1973, attended Bethel College School of Theology, and was ordained to the Christian ministry in 1986. He is the founder/senior pastor of Covenant Church in Redlands. He obtained a doctorate in theology from the Center for the Study of Biblical Research.

Turley is a national and international speaker and is the lead facilitator for International Renewal Ministries and for the Pastors' Prayer Summit. He is a past chairman of the So Calif Council of Pastors and Leaders and serves on numerous boards. Turley also is the founding member of the RCRC and the RCRC, Inc., a founding member of the Venture Foundation, and is the board chairman of the Blessing Center in Redlands (addresses all facets of poverty) in and around Redlands. He is married to his wife, Kim, and has 2 adult sons.
